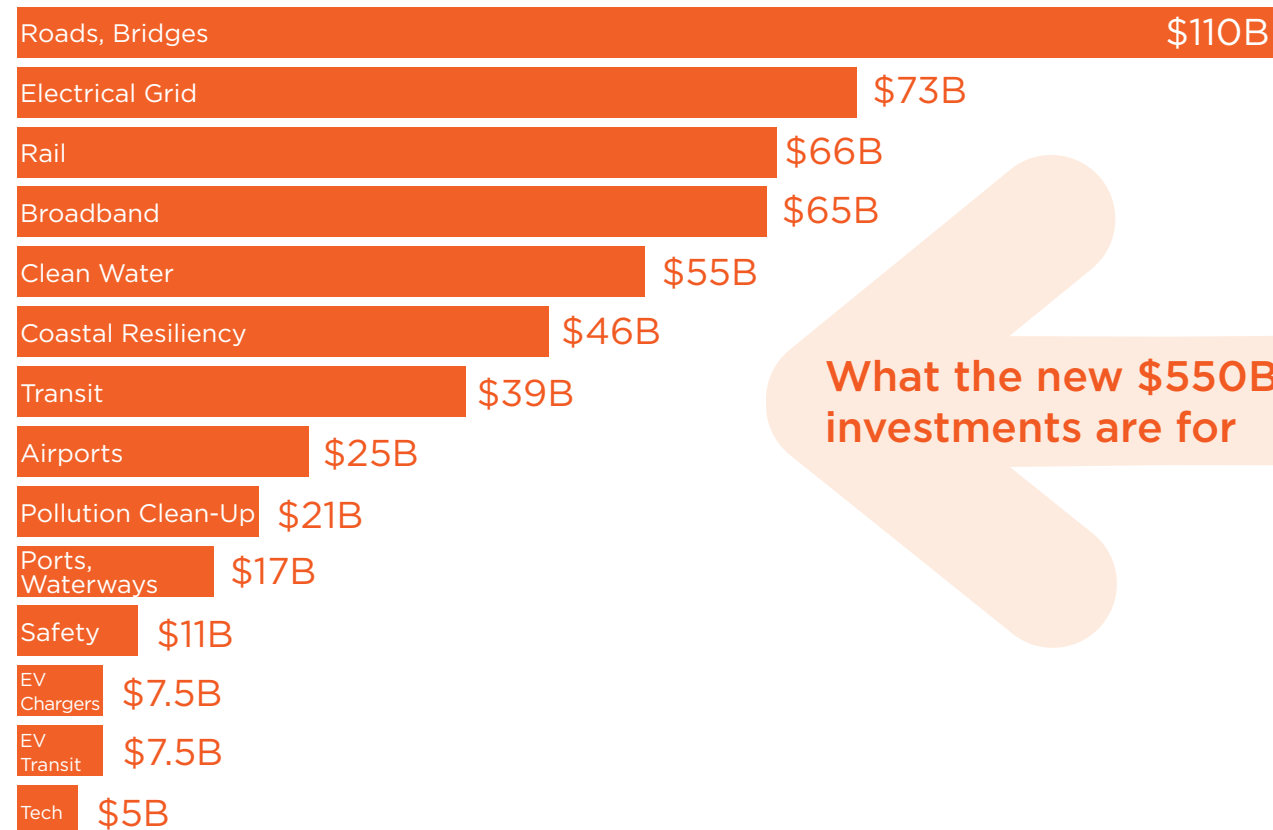

What's in the Law?

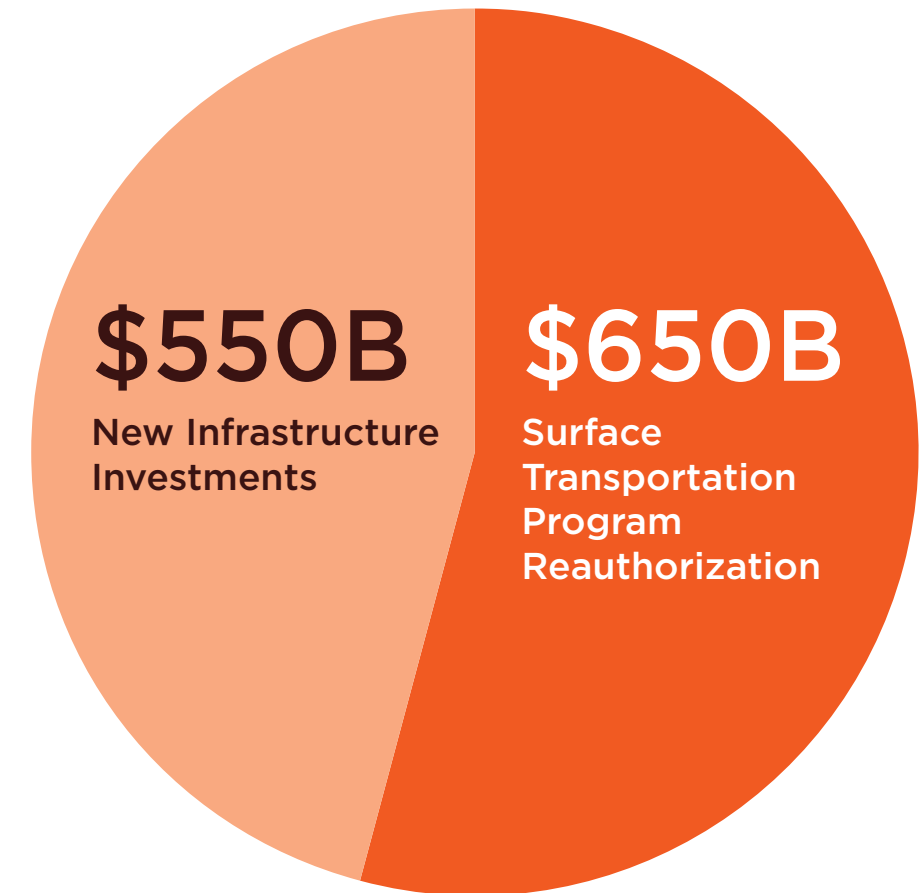
The law is exclusively focused on funding real infrastructure. The majority of funding, roughly \$650 billion, is simply for reauthorization of the surface transportation program, which Congress needs to do every several years just to maintain our nation's already badly aging infrastructure. The remaining \$550 billion will be used for new investments to start modernizing and building infrastructure like roads, bridges, airports, broadband, water, and electrical grids.



How Is It Paid For?

\$550 billion for new infrastructure improvements is paid for in a responsible way without raising taxes and will help generate billions in economic growth for decades to come.

The law is funded in part by using unspent unemployment insurance and unspent COVID-19 recovery funding.

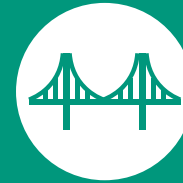

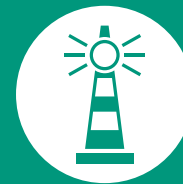

Rural Broadband Expansion Across North Carolina

One of the key provisions of the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law that Senator Tillis helped negotiate was expanding access to broadband services in rural communities. In total, North Carolina will receive at least **\$1.5 billion**, and counties across the state are already receiving broadband grants.

DID YOU KNOW?



More than **400,000** North Carolinians lack access to high-speed internet, including many who live in rural communities that do not have any high-speed internet infrastructure.

Some Examples of Broadband Funding Already Awarded Include:

Lenoir County

Secured more than **\$29 million** to bring high-speed internet to 15,256 unserved households.

Warren and Halifax Counties

Secured **\$17.5 million** to deploy a fiber-to-the-premises network to connect 5,434 people, 100 businesses, 76 farms, and 22 educational facilities to high-speed internet.

Robeson and Scotland Counties

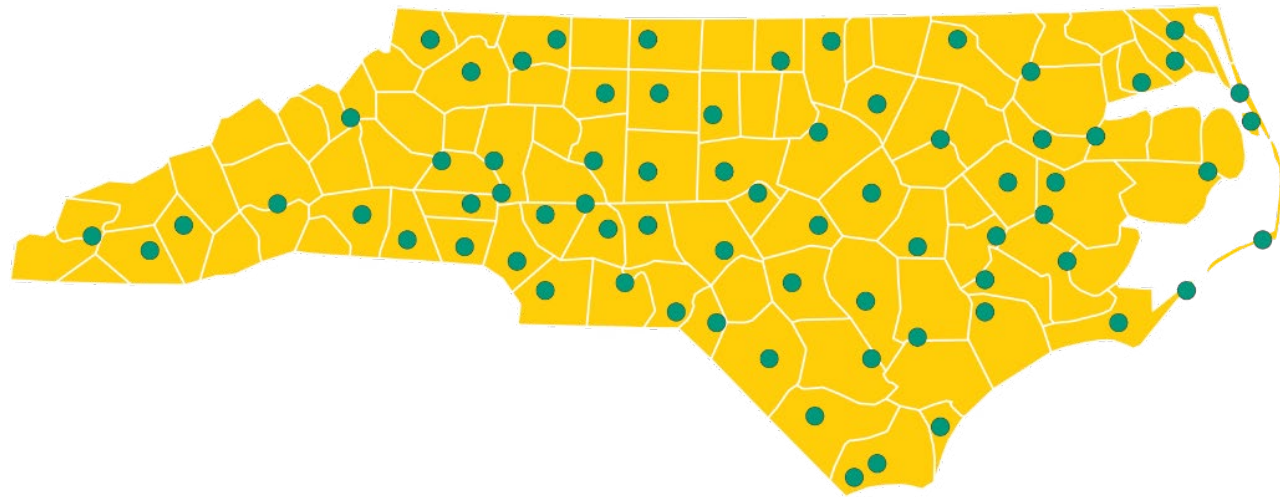
Secured **\$25 million** to connect 13,972 people, 198 businesses, 166 farms, and 18 public schools to high-speed internet.

A number of colleges and universities are also receiving grants to expand broadband access to students. Johnson C. Smith University in Charlotte secured a \$5.7 million grant for the purchase of broadband internet service and to train information technology personnel. Fayetteville State University in Fayetteville secured a \$4.9 million grant to improve broadband utilization and cybersecurity. Bennett College in Greensboro secured a \$700K grant to ensure adequate broadband and Wi-Fi capabilities on campus.



Modernizing NC's Airports

71 Airports across North Carolina have received **\$458 million** from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, including Asheville Regional Airport, which received a \$15 million grant. This new funding will be used for a terminal expansion project to add adequate space for ticketing and hold rooms that meet requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

Ensuring Access to Safe and Clean Drinking Water

North Carolina unfortunately has had a long and tragic history with toxic water contamination, and many families are rightfully concerned about PFAS and other emerging contaminants in their drinking water. Senator Tillis has worked to ensure communities have clean water from the ground to the tap, which is why he led efforts to push the EPA to designate PFAS as a hazardous substance.

The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law takes major steps to provide all North Carolinians with access to safe and clean drinking water, making it the largest investment in clean water in American history. Senator Tillis worked to secure a \$61 million grant to address emerging contaminants like PFAS in North Carolina's drinking water, allowing communities to prioritize infrastructure and source water treatment for pollutants and to conduct water quality testing.



DID YOU KNOW?

In total, North Carolina is expected to receive **\$440 million** to support clean water infrastructure thanks to the **Bipartisan Infrastructure Law**.





Investments to Better Prepare for Storms

North Carolina is no stranger to devastating storms and flooding that have tragically taken lives and destroyed entire communities.

Many of those communities have then faced bureaucratic delays that have prevented them from beginning mitigation projects immediately following a natural disaster. The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law takes these challenges into account, and many of our coastal towns will receive much-needed aid so they can invest more in resiliency to be better prepared for future natural disasters.

Thanks to the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, North Carolina has already been awarded **\$144.2 million** for infrastructure resiliency, including flood mitigation investments that will allow the Army Corps of Engineers to deepen waterways and make our coast better prepared for future storms.

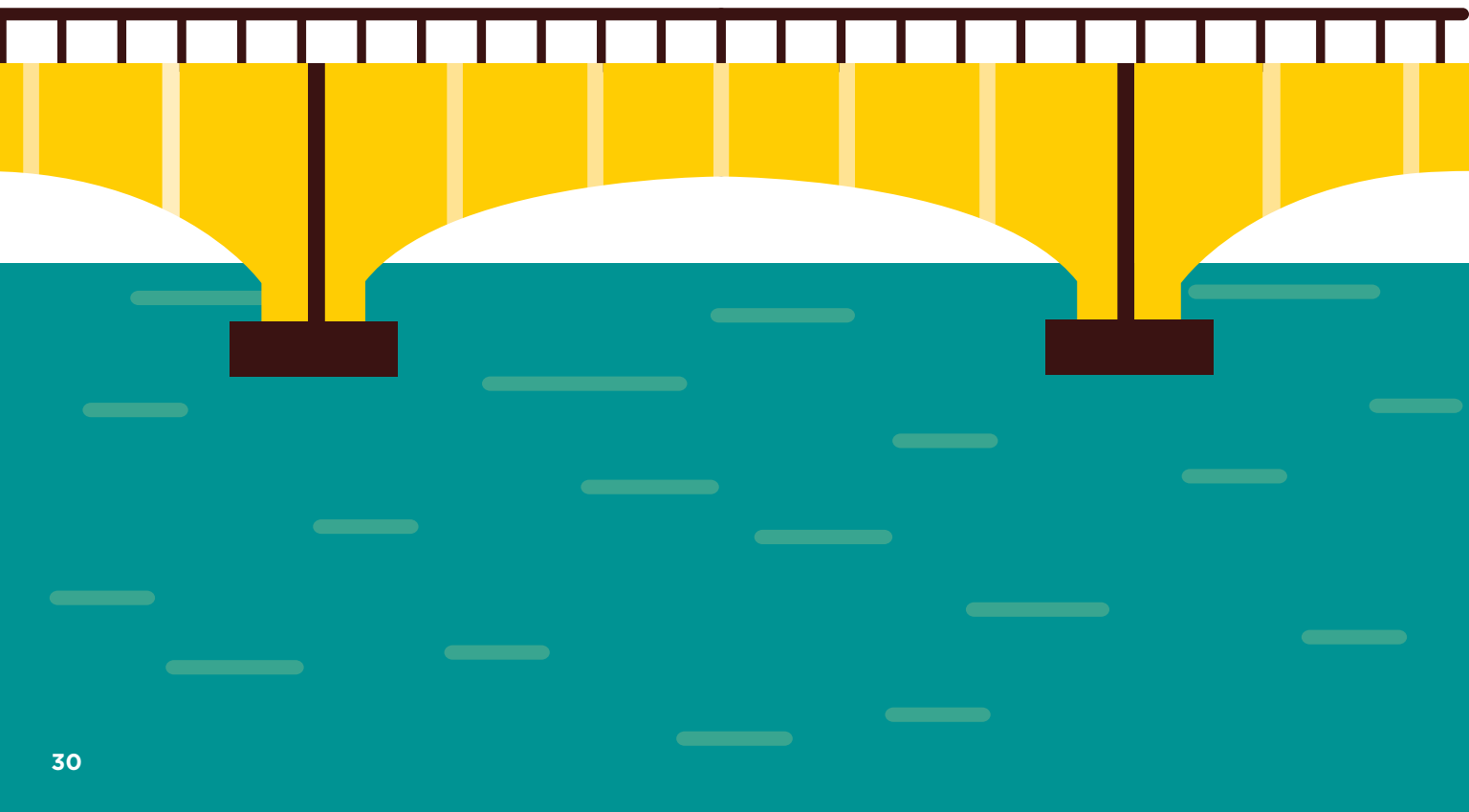

SUCCESS STORIES



Alligator River Bridge

Senator Tillis secured a **\$110 million** grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation to replace the Alligator River Bridge on U.S. Highway 64 in Dare and Tyrrell Counties. The new bridge will be approximately 3.2 miles in length, with a vertical clearance of 65 feet to accommodate the navigational channel, and two 12-foot separate bicycle traffices from vehicle traffic.

Improving Highway Safety and Commute Times in the Charlotte Metro Area

Cleveland and Gaston Counties received a **\$100 million** grant to fund a major project to widen a segment of I-85, add auxiliary lanes for interchanges, and replace a number of railroad bridges.

The project will improve driver safety and account for the region's fast-growing population that has contributed to significant traffic for commuters. As the *Gaston Gazette* reported, "[This is] welcome news for just about anyone in Gaston or Cleveland Counties who has ever been stuck in a I-85 traffic jam either going to work in Charlotte or coming home at night."



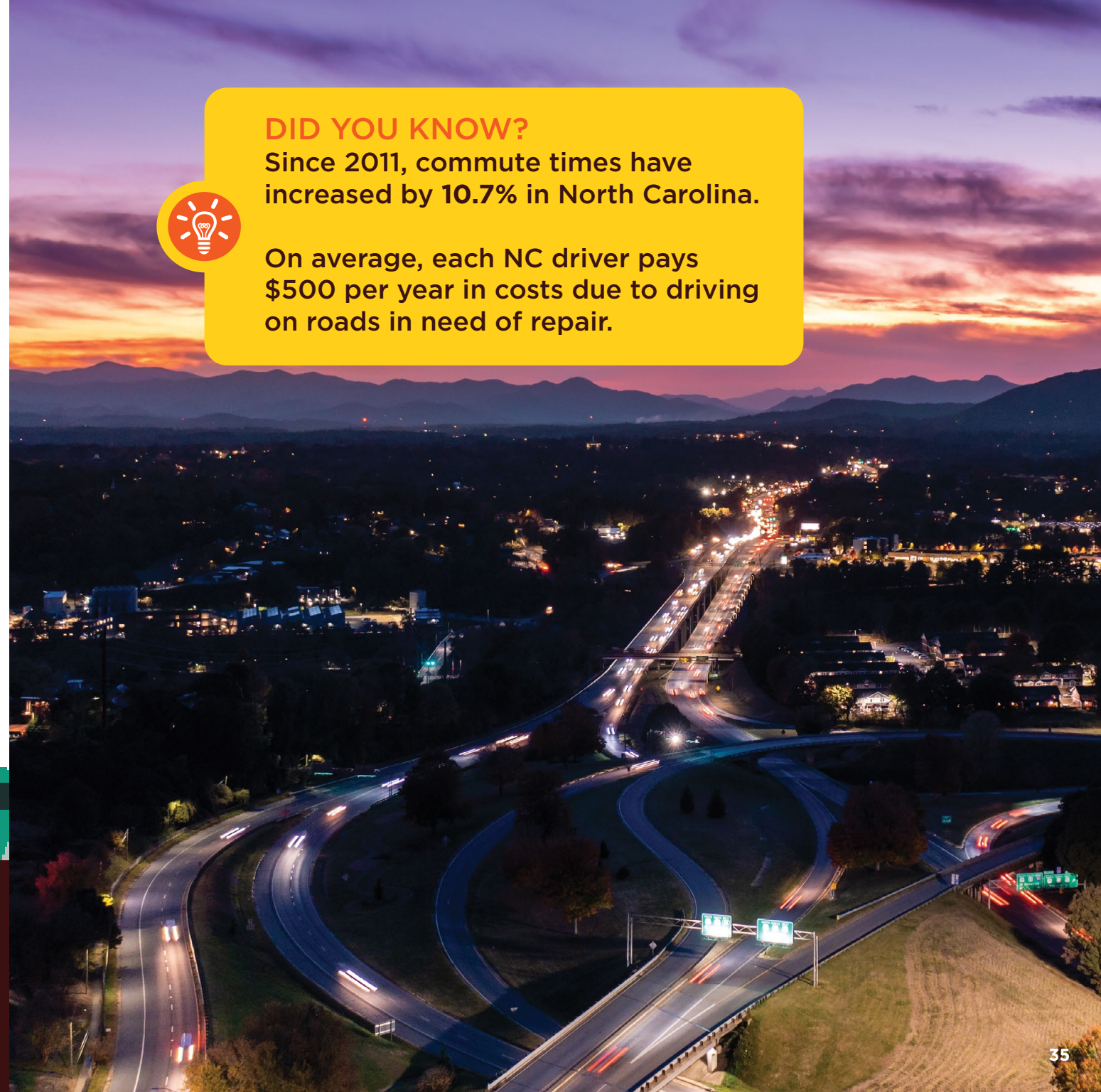
DID YOU KNOW?

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the three North Carolina cities with the longest average one-way commute times are Charlotte (25.5 minutes), Durham (24 minutes), and Raleigh (23 minutes).

Reducing Traffic in Western North Carolina

A major construction project aimed at reducing traffic congestion on 17 miles stretching across Interstate 26 received more than **\$47 million** from the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law.

As a resident engineer told the *Transylvania Times*, "It's no secret to anybody that lives in our area or who drives on I-26 that we have issues with congestion. People have to base their schedules around that. They need to leave for work earlier, or factor traffic when going to a doctor's appointment or a child's ballgame. This project will be more reliable for people getting to their destinations and will improve their lives because they're not sitting in traffic."

Why Participate in the Bipartisan Infrastructure Negotiations?

My main priority in taking part in this bipartisan group was to ensure it met the needs of our state, including investments in North Carolina's roads, highways, and bridges. I also wanted to ensure that the legislation did not include some of the progressive policies proposed by President Biden and some House members, including parts of the Green New Deal. I was pleased that the final product focuses on hard infrastructure and is a significant win for North Carolina.

How Is the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Funded?

The \$550 billion in new infrastructure spending is responsibly paid for without raising any taxes. Funding streams include repurposing hundreds of billions of dollars of unspent COVID relief funds, and funding from states returning unused unemployment benefits provided during the COVID pandemic. Additionally, these infrastructure investments will generate billions in economic output for decades to come.

What About the Claims That Only a Small Percentage of the Funding Actually Goes Toward Infrastructure?

Those claims simply aren't true. This is a real infrastructure bill that funds hard infrastructure. You can see the spending breakdown on page 10. To believe this bill doesn't actually fund real infrastructure, one would also have to believe that real infrastructure doesn't include things like water infrastructure, the electrical grid, coastal resiliency, flood mitigation, broadband, airports, rails, public transit, and road safety.

Is This Infrastructure Law Part of the Biden Administration's "Inflation Reduction Act" Spending Plan?

No, the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law is completely different from the "Inflation Reduction Act," which was a partisan spending bill that contained numerous so-called "human infrastructure" policies including tax increases and Green New Deal regulations. I strongly opposed and voted against the Inflation Reduction Act.

Does the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Include a Mileage Tax?

No, there is no mileage tax or any other tax increase in the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law. It is worth noting that there have been robust debates about a mileage tax for the owners of electric cars because they pay no gas taxes, which are used by the government to repair roads. That means currently, owners of regular cars paying for the road damage caused by electric cars, while owners of electric cars pay nothing. This inherent unfairness is an issue that will eventually have to be addressed by Congress.

Does the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Mandate Breathalyzers in Cars?

No, the claim that the bill requires breathalyzers or ignition interlock devices to be installed in cars is false. The mandate some are referring to is for a completely different safety technology that is intended to prevent car accidents. New cars will be required to include life-saving technology including emergency braking, crash avoidance systems, and other features that will help prevent serious injury during a collision.

Does the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law Include the “Green New Deal”?

Absolutely not, it focuses on our core infrastructure needs. There was a false claim circulating that only a tiny fraction of this legislation supports core infrastructure, and the rest is “Green New Deal” excess spending. That is simply not true, and in order to believe this false claim, one would have to view investments in water infrastructure, the electrical grid, coastal resiliency, flood mitigation, broadband, airports, rails, public transit, and road safety as outside the definition of infrastructure. I would never support legislation that included the Green New Deal.
